Our Inspiration


Our mission is inspired by the deep truth of these three words:

I am you and you are me. We are all One.






The Eyes of Love

About her life in Calcutta serving "the poorest of the poor"


Mother Teresa also said;

Entering Our Second Decade In Panama


As we enter the second decade of Everyman Foundation in Panama, let us honor Mother Teresa's memory by recommitting ourselves:

We Can Give Love


When we think we have nothing we can give please remember this:

A final thought on love:


Would everyone please close their eyes
